#### WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

\*\* UNO is opening the 2009-10 home campaign on Thursday night against SUNO. The contest will kick off a three-game homestand.

\*\* UNO sophomore guard **Charles Carmouche** is coming off a career-high 20 points in Friday's loss at Georgia.

\*\* The Privateers had won seven straight home openers prior to last year's 65-59 loss to North Carolina State.

\*\* UNO is trying to avoid an 0-2 start for the third time in the last four years.

#### LAKEFRONT DEBUT

UNO senior guard **Billy Humphrey** will make his Lakefront Arena debut on Thursday.

Humphrey, two weeks removed from arthroscopic knee surgery in late October, scored 11 points and played 32 minutes in the season opener at Georgia on Friday.

Humphrey played three years at Georgia before transferring to UNO. He helped the Bulldogs to an improbable SEC Tournament championship in 2008 when the Bulldogs won three games in two days to claim the automatic NCAA Tournament bid.

## LAST TIME OUT...Nov. 13, 2009

ATHENS, Ga. -- University of Georgia forward Trey Thompkins is one of the most heralded young players in the SEC. On Friday night, he showed why.

The 6-10, 247-pound sophomore had 25 points and 12 rebounds as the host-Bulldogs controlled the boards in a 67-59 win over visiting New Orleans at Stegeman Coliseum.

Thompkins had 16 points in the first half, and the Bulldogs (1-0) got 12 points from reserve forward Jeremy Price to help the hosts claim the win for first-year head coach Mark Fox.

Sophomore guard **Charles Carmouche** had a career-high 20 points for the Privateers (0-1), and junior center **Jaroslav Tyrna** had 16 points and seven rebounds.

But UNO could not overcome a 41-27 rebound advantage for Georgia. The effort helped the Bulldogs score 17 second-chance points while UNO was shut out.

The Privateers also struggled from the field in the second half, shooting 30 percent. UNO shot 38 percent overall.

Along with Carmouche and Tyrna, the Privateers got a shot in the arm from senior **Billy Humphrey**. The Chicago native, who played three seasons at Georgia before transferring in 2008, scored 11 points and played 31 minutes just two weeks after arthroscopic knee surgery.

The Privateers had a shot at the upset. UNO trailed 34-32 at halftime before an 11-4 run to start the second frame gave the Privateers a 43-38 lead with 17:22 to play.

UNO led for the next six minutes before Georgia took a 46-45 edge thanks to a Drazen Zlovacic jumper with 11 minutes to play.

The score was part of an 11-0 run that put UNO behind 51-45 following a Thompkins layup with 9:51 remaining.

The Privateers got it within two on two different occasions, including a Tyrna 3-pointer with 2:05 to play. But Georgia went 7-for-8 at the free-throw line in the final minute to ice it.

## HEAD COACH JOE PASTERNAK



UNO head coach Joe Pasternak is entering his third year on the Lakefront in 2009-10, and he has already given the program something it needed most: Stability.

Becoming the school's third head coach in three years in July 2007, Pasternak quickly made his mark. In 2007-08, he led UNO to 19 wins, the school's most since 1997, and helped the Privateers defeat a nationally-ranked team (then-No. 21 NC State) for the first time since 1993.

He quickly put his stamp on the UNO program by bringing in 11 newcomers for 2008-09 after his inaugural squad lost six seniors. The recruiting class was ranked among the best in the Sun Belt Conference.

He will start his third year with a roster totally recruited by himself and his staff. But it is possibly off the court where Pasternak has made his biggest contribution. The 32-year old was instrumental in the athletic department receiving the largest gift in school history. Local businessmen John Georges and former UNO standout Gabe Corchiani donated \$1 million to the basketball program, and the gift was used to design a brand new locker room

at Lakefront Arena, as well as create a new video room.

He also helped organize a roast for former UNO head coach Tim Floyd, which raised \$50,000. The event funded UNO's 2009 Labor Day weekend trip to Cancun, Mexico.

The 11th head coach in UNO history, Pasternak was a perfect fit with his New Orleans ties (a graduate of Metairie Park Country Day School) and impressive coaching pedigree.

For four years, he studied under legendary great Bobby Knight as a student manager at Indiana. After graduating with a marketing degree in 1999, Pasternak then embarked on an eight-year stint at California.

Working under head coach Ben Braun, now the head man at Rice, Pasternak was involved in every area of the program. Cutting his teeth as the video coordinator, he was promoted to assistant coach in 2001 and spent six seasons on the Berkeley bench before moving to the Crescent City.

Pasternak and his wife, Lindsay, have a son -- Joe IV.
